REGULAR BASIC COURSE

Modular Format Academy- Module II

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course satisfies training requirements of the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Module II. Topics include: property crimes, crimes against persons, crimes against the justice system, laws of arrest, search and seizure, presentation of evidence, patrol techniques, vehicle pullovers, crimes in progress, lifetime fitness, and career preparation. POST certification #2970-00140. Pass/No Pass only.

IMPORTANT: **Students are required to participate in practical hands-on and physically demanding training exercises that include risk of injury.*

***Applicants who have completed Mod III and are returning within 1 year are required, by POST, to pass Mod III end of course examination prior to admittance. This may be accomplished by submitting an application and contacting the Academy to reserve a seat for the Mod III end of course exam scheduled for March 5, 2019. Details will be provided when the Academy is contacted.*

ENROLLMENT LIMITATIONS: Students must 1) be free of felony convictions 2) possess a valid California Driver's License 3) undergo a fingerprint and criminal history check 4) be a minimum of 18 years of age 5) be a United States high school graduate, pass the GED, pass the California High School Proficiency Examination, or have attained a two-year or four-year degree from an accredited college or university, and 6) complete a medical suitability examination

PREREQUISITES: **PSTC 1502 (Basic Law Enforcement Academy-Module III) or Certificate of Completion of POST certified Module III Law Enforcement Academy within 1 year of the Module II start date.**

SCHEDULE: Monday, January 10 – Wednesday, June 8, 2022... ..Spring 2022

HOURS: Module II consists of 261 instructional hours and meets on a weekly basis:

Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays: 5:30 p.m. – 10:00 p.m.

Saturdays: 6:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Course hours may also be scheduled on Fridays or Sundays to meet training specifications.
