CRIME PREVENTION THROUGH ENVIRONMENTAL DESIGN

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design is a 40-hour course designed for crime prevention personnel, city and county planners dealing with environmental designs. Topics include: reviewing new construction submittals and its impact on law enforcement, community policing, problem solving and theory and process.

Upon completion of the course, all students will receive an ARC SRPSTC Certificate of Completion and a grade submitted for their college transcripts. Only in-service peace officers shall receive POST credit. The class venue is a computer lab. Personal computers are not needed

Important Note: *Students are strongly encouraged to arrive on time in order to complete the registration process and avoid impeding instructional time. Late students who miss this process will not be allowed to attend the course. You will need your Los Rios student number (W#) and password to access the computers and Wi-Fi/internet.*

PREREQUISITES: None

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- 1) Each student needs to bring a digital camera (digital cell phone is ok as long as they can download photos) and accessories if needed. Members of law enforcement attending the course are urged to bring a developer or planner from their organization.
- 2) Each student **will be provided with a 4GB USB drive** which will be needed for class lab work.
