

Firearms Rifle Instructor - Update

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Firearms/Rifle Instructor - Update is a 24-hour course designed to provide the law enforcement firearms instructor with contemporary information on legal issues, liability issues, updated training techniques and skills assessment in the use of the short barreled patrol rifle. Topics include: instructional techniques, close-quarter combat and active shooter techniques, maintenance, and deployment shooting techniques.

Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participants.

Upon completion of the course, all students will receive an ARC SRPSTC Certificate of Completion and a grade submitted for their college transcripts. Only in-service peace officers shall receive POST credit.

Effective 11/7/24: for safety purposes neither students nor instructors are allowed to bring or use the Sig Sauer P320 at the JPA range.

ENROLLMENT

To register: Everyone must complete a Course Reservation & Payment Form and either fax (916) 570-5023 or scan/email it to this office at srpstc@arc.losrios.edu. Students are also required to complete the mandatory college enrollment process* prior to the first day of class.

Students must 1) Be free of felony convictions; 2) possess a valid California Driver's License; 3) undergo a fingerprint and criminal history check; 4) be a minimum of 18 years of age; 5) be a United States high school graduate; pass the GED, pass the California High School Proficiency Examination, or have attained a two-year or four-year degree from an accredited college or university; and 6) complete a medical suitability examination.
