

# JUVENILE CORRECTIONS OFFICER CORE

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

Juvenile Corrections Officer Core is an intensive 168-hour course designed for new juvenile corrections officers and students interested in a career in the juvenile corrections field. It covers the California criminal justice system, professionalism and ethics, defensive tactics, report writing, mental health challenges, gangs, physical conditioning, social justice, cultural awareness, and behavioral health. This course is certified by California Standards and Training for Corrections (STC). It was formerly known as PSTC 1519. Pass/No Pass only.

Upon successful completion of this course, all students will receive 7.5 units and a digital SRPSTC Certificate of Completion. In-service peace officers may also be eligible for CA POST/STC credit, depending on agency requirements.
