

# PC 832 Firearms Familiarization

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

PC 832 Firearms Familiarization is a 24-hour course designed to comply with California Penal Code 832 as well as requirements by Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST). This course is a basic introduction to the legal aspects of shooting and safety. Topics include: handgun familiarization, safety, shooting principles and live fire exercises. Because this course is designed to provide practical hands-on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participant.

Effective 11/7/24: for safety purposes neither students nor instructors are allowed to bring or use the Sig Sauer P320 at the JPA range.

Upon successful completion of this course, all students will receive 0.5 units and a digital SRPSTC Certificate of Completion. In-service peace officers may also be eligible for CA POST/STC credit, depending on agency requirements.

### IMPORTANT

All students must submit a DOJ Criminal History Clearance and Medical Clearance letter/form prior to the start of the course, and must be at least 18 years of age. Clearance letters must be no older than 6 months prior to the last day of the class.

IMPORTANT: A Glock Model 19 9mm semi-automatic pistol is provided for this course. Personal and non-Law Enforcement Agency assigned weapons are not allowed. Law Enforcement personnel requesting to use their department issued firearm and ammunition, must obtain prior approval from the Course Coordinator, Victor Almager, who can be reached at [AlmageV@arc.losrios.edu](mailto:AlmageV@arc.losrios.edu) and cc: [RowleyL@arc.losrios.edu](mailto:RowleyL@arc.losrios.edu).

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 01, 2022: Students will be required to purchase 400 rounds of factory loaded 115 grain 9mm full metal jacket (FMJ) ammunition. Steel case and non-factory loaded ammunition are prohibited. This is also available from the Sacramento Regional Public Safety Training Center at the cost of \$112.00 on the first day of class. This cost is not reflected in the student's material fees for the course. Each student will be issued a Glock model 19 semiautomatic pistol from the district for use in the course. Students who bring unapproved ammunition and/or firearms will be dismissed from the class.

Certificates will expire in 3 years unless kept active by being employed as a Peace Officer with arrest powers

## COURSE DETAILS

### ENROLLMENT

Students must 1) Be free of felony convictions; 2) possess a valid California Driver's License; 3) undergo a fingerprint and criminal history check; 4) be a minimum of 18 years of age; 5) be a United States high school graduate; pass the GED, pass the California High School Proficiency Examination, or have attained a two-year or four-year degree from an accredited college or university; and 6) complete a medical suitability examination.

To Register: Everyone must complete a Course Registration Form. Students are also required to complete the mandatory college enrollment process prior to enrolling in class.
