

# PROBATION OFFICER CORE

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

Probation Officer Core is an intensive 189-hour course designed for entry-level positions in the probation officer field. Topics include: criminal justice system, legal foundations, terminology, codes, statutes, case law, indicators of psychological problems, gangs, interviews, court reports, and report writing.

Upon successful completion of this course, all students will receive 9 units and a digital SRPSTC Certificate of Completion. In-service peace officers may also be eligible for CA POST/STC credit, depending on agency requirements.
