

# REGULATORY INVESTIGATIVE TECHNIQUES

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

Regulatory Investigative Techniques is a 40-hour course designed for the law enforcement officer assigned to an investigative role within a state agency. The course focuses on techniques that enhance the investigator's ability to prepare a criminal or administrative case for prosecution in a criminal or administrative hearing. Topics include: roles and responsibilities, interview techniques, search warrants and report writing.

Upon successful completion of this course, all students will receive 2 units and a digital SRPSTC Certificate of Completion. In-service peace officers may also be eligible for CA POST/STC credit, depending on agency requirements.
