

# TRAFFIC COLLISION INVESTIGATION - Intermediate

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

Traffic Collision Investigation (Intermediate) is a 40-hour course designed to expand the investigative knowledge and skills of the traffic collision investigator. Topics include definitions and terminologies associated with minor and major collisions, measuring and diagramming the collision scene and speed computation.

Upon successful completion of this course, all students will receive 2 units and a digital SRPSTC Certificate of Completion. In-service peace officers may also be eligible for CA POST/STC credit, depending on agency requirements.

The course will use extensive practical application and field exercise, which will require additional course work outside of class hours.

### ENROLLMENT

Students must 1) Be free of felony convictions; 2) possess a valid California Driver's License; 3) undergo a fingerprint and criminal history check; 4) be a minimum of 18 years of age; 5) be a United States high school graduate; pass the GED, pass the California High School Proficiency Examination, or have attained a two-year or four-year degree from an accredited college or university; and 6) complete a medical suitability examination.

To Register: Everyone must complete a Course Registration Form. Students are also required to complete the mandatory college enrollment process prior to enrolling in class.
